**In Violation of:**

Title 21, U.S.C., §:846

Title 21, U.S.C., §:841(a)(1)

COUNT ONE

The Grand Jury charges:

1. That on a date unknown, but no later than 2007 through October 24, 2008, in the Western Judicial District of Virginia and elsewhere, the defendant, CYNTHIA KAYE NICHOLS, willfully and knowingly attempted and or combined, conspired, confederated and agreed with diverse other persons known and unknown to the Grand Jury, to commit the following offenses against the United States, to wit: to possess with intent to distribute or distribute a measurable quantity of a mixture or substance containing heroin, the use of which resulted in serious bodily injury, a Schedule I controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

2. All in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

COUNT TWO

The Grand Jury charges:

1. That on or about the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2008, in the Western Judicial District of Virginia, the defendant, CYNTHIA KAYE NICHOLS, did knowingly and intentionally distribute a measurable quantity of a mixture or substance containing heroin, the use of which resulted in serious bodily injury, a Schedule I controlled substance.

2. In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

COUNT THREE

The Grand Jury charges:

1. That on or about the 16<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2008, in the Western Judicial District of Virginia, the defendant, CYNTHIA KAYE NICHOLS, did knowingly and intentionally distribute a measurable quantity of a mixture or substance containing heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance.

2. In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

COUNT FOUR

The Grand Jury charges:

1. That on or about the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2008, in the Western Judicial District of Virginia, the defendant, CYNTHIA KAYE NICHOLS, did knowingly and intentionally distribute a measurable quantity of a mixture or substance containing heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance.

2. In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

COUNT FIVE

The Grand Jury charges:


1. That on or about the 16<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2008, in the Western Judicial District of Virginia, the defendant, CYNTHIA KAYE NICHOLS, did knowingly and intentionally distribute a measurable quantity of a mixture or substance containing heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance.
2. In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).


COUNT SIX
