Dear Ms. Carr:

Like you, I was surprised that you were found guilty of the credit card offenses. As I'm sure you know, we cannot appeal your convictions until after you are sentenced on those matters. At this time, my intent at sentencing is to ask the court to consider giving you no active time and placing you on probation, especially in light of the fact that you are already serving a lengthy prison sentence. I cannot promise what the court will do but the above is what I intend to argue for on your behalf. I was aware of most of your health problems and we will inform the court of your numerous health problems, as well as your children, at the sentencing hearing.

I have issued a subpoena for the following people: Louis Swanson, Leslie Terry and Sandra Raymond. That is everyone but Richard Calhoun. Since he is a North Carolina resident, the subpoena process can take at least thirty days and could reach forty-five days to secure an interstate witness subpoena. Additionally, an out of state witness subpoena will only be issued for a pending trial or grand jury proceeding and only for a material witness in that trial or grand jury proceeding. As such, I have written a letter to Mr. Calhoun, requesting he appear to assist you in the sentencing. Enclosed is a copy of the letter I mailed to him.

As for your civil rights claim, I am glad to hear you are starting that process. I do not practice much civil law and do not know whether you **need** an attorney, but I always feel it's advisable to have an attorney when proceeding with a court matter, especially one as explosive as this. I cannot advise you as to how to proceed because this particular matter is outside my area of expertise. Apart from a civil rights claim, I would believe you also have a criminal complaint against any one who raped or sexually molested you while in their custody (including his employer, the county, the state, etc.). I believe you have done the best thing by writing to persons outside of this area and contacting the FBI and VSP. They will certainly conduct a criminal investigation into what has been covered up by local authorities to this point.

This office has received your letter requesting clemency. In your petition you claim that you are innocent of the crime for which you were convicted and for which you are seeking clemency.

The 2004 Session of the Virginia General Assembly enacted legislation giving individuals convicted of crime the opportunity to have the court consider claims of innocence even after their conviction. This legislation is in the Code of Virginia as Sections 19.2-327 through 19.2-327.13.

Petitions for clemency are appropriate for consideration only after all judicial remedies have been exhausted, including this new remedy. Your letter does not address the applicability of this new remedy to your situation.

You may submit your petition along with evidence that the court has rejected your claim under this new law or an explanation of the legal basis for why you believe the new law is not applicable to your situation.

I am writing in response to your complaint letter dated on or about July, 2006, addressed to Jessica Huckenmeyer.

In order for the FBI to initiate an investigation of any allegation that we receive, specific facts must be set forth to demonstrate a violation of federal law has occurred. Following a thorough review of your information, there appears to be insufficient evidence to demonstrate that a civil rights violation has occurred. Therefore, we are requesting you to provide in writing, a more detailed account of the incident. This would include medical documents, photos of injuries, the name and contact information of any witnesses who may have observed the incident and any documents pertaining to your complaint. Subsequent to receiving the above requested information, we will review your complaint and notify you of the findings.
